Safety, Health and Environment Policy

General Statement of Intent - 2018

- 1) Severfield (UK) Limited considers successful safety, health, environmental and sustainable management to be of prime importance to its business and is committed to continual improvement in safety, health and environmental standards.
- 2) It is the policy of Severfield (UK) Limited to:
 - Comply with all legislative requirements and the Severfield group policy pertaining to safety, health and the environment as the minimum standard;
 - Develop systems and procedures that deliver the high standards sought, and in particular provide for:
 - Well maintained plant and systems of work that are safe to both health and/or the environment;
 - Suitable arrangements for the selection, use, handling, storage and transport of articles and substances;
 - Adequate information, instruction, training and supervision to enable work to be carried out safely by persons with the necessary competence;
 - Safe premises and work places, including access to and egress from them;
 - Safe and healthy working environments with adequate welfare facilities;
 - Designs which recognise, include and apply safe practice during both preparation, construction and subsequent operational use and maintenance after completion of the project, and which consider environmental impact;
 - Control of polluting emissions to air, land or water;
 - Management of the use of natural resources;
 - Control of noise, dust, smell, vibration, traffic movement or other nuisance or environmental effects which may cause offence to the local community or environment;
 - Waste minimisation;
 - Management of waste disposal including recycling where appropriate;
 - Communications, health surveillance and advisory facilities as required.
 - Develop and review clear safety, health and environmental performance indicators including:
 - accident and incident performance;
 - annual safety, health and environmental objectives;
 - training achievement;
 - audits.
 - Pursue high standards of safety, health and environmental management as an integral part of efficient management of the business and ensure that decisions about other priorities take proper account of safety, health and environmental requirements;
 - Review and, if necessary, revise this policy on an annual basis.
- 3) The Managing Director has overall responsibility for this policy. Severfield (UK) Limited's Policy has appointed a director to be responsible for safety, health and environment whose responsibilities are set out in the policy documents.
- 4) Severfield (UK) Limited will produce and update detailed organisation and arrangements, and all necessary resources will be made available, for the implementation of this policy.
- 5) It is the responsibility of management and employees to implement this policy together with their collective and individual responsibilities. Individuals' responsibilities under this policy are set out in the policy documents.
- 6) Severfield (UK) Limited will utilise the Group Safety Health and Environment Department to provide adequate SHE advice and inspection services for both Lostock and Dalton Factory units and construction sites.
